## **BMLA WRITES THE BOOK ON WATER CONSERVATION**

April 16, 2008 Corona, CA. The City of Fontana, California has commissioned the Landscape Architecture firm of BMLA to develop a water conservation strategy program.

The strategy will be incorporated into all Fontana public landscape areas. BMLA's preparation for this document was in direct response to Fontana's strong desire to promote water-efficient landscaping, water use management and water conservation.

The BMLA water conservation strategy could serve as a guideline for current Southern Californian landscape maintenance areas as well as set design standards for future landscape installations to meet water conservation goals.

BMLA has strived for 20 plus years to lead water conservation efforts in Southern California. BMLA has worked with several municipalities including Eastern Municipal Water District to analyze existing site conditions and provide solutions that demonstrate significant water savings. BMLA design incorporated organic and inorganic material that resulted in water savings estimated at 70% under the previous installation.
